## THE MARVELLOUS, MECHANICAL, MUSICAL MUSEUM!

Join the Master and company on **Thursday 8th March** for an exciting and tuneful day out at the UK's finest collection of automated musical instruments, situated a few minutes' walk from Kew Bridge, West London.

The Musical Museum is home to a wonderful collection of self-playing mechanical musical instruments. From the tiniest of clockwork music boxes to the mighty Wurlitzer theatre organ in the concert hall, you can listen to and learn about an impressive array of reproducing pianos, orchestrions, pipe organs and violin players.

We will have the museum all to ourselves and our tour guide will be on hand to take us through the collection and answer any and all questions.

The tour will finish with a Wurlitzer recital in the concert hall by one of the Museum's organists, and we are hoping to persuade the Master to give us a turn too!

After the show, we have arranged lunch nearby at the Stable Restaurant, offering a wonderful selection of Pies, Pizzas, Salad and Cider. It's a day, and lunch, not to be missed.

**Itinerary:** 10.45 - 11.00: Meet at the Museum - 399 High St, Brentford TW8 0DU (trains every 15 mins from London Waterloo to Kew Bridge Station. The Museum is a 6 minute walk away. Suggest 10.07 (Arr 10.35) or 10.22 (arr 10.50). There is a **small** car park on site for visitors arriving by car. Welcome coffee, tea and biscuits served until 11 for early arrivals.

11.00 - 12.45: Tour of the Museum.

12.45 - 13.15: Wurlitzer Recital (with Magisterial additions), then a short walk to...

13.30 - 14.30: The Stable Restaurant for a 2 course lunch and a glass of wine, beer or cider.

**Cost:** £30 per person (including a donation to the Museum, a 2 course lunch, a drink and gratuities).

**Menu options:**

**EITHER** PIE (all served with herb roasted potatoes, a pickled onion and tomato chutney):

- 1) The Steak Out - beef, mushroom, stout and horseradish.
- 2) The Rooster - chicken, gammon and leek with a thyme crust.
- 3) The Squish Squash - spiced butternut squash, sweet potato, goats' cheese, spinach and plum chutney.

**OR** PIZZA (Sourdough base; gluten-free also available):

- 1) Four Cheese Special with tomato - Wookey Hole aged cheddar, Dorset Blue Vinney, Billy The Kid goats' cheese cheddar, Ford Farm smoked red cheese.
- 2) Denhay Delight - crispy Denhay Farm dry-cured bacon, field mushrooms, tomato sauce and mozzarella. Topped with a free-range egg.
- 3) Kew Garden Grazer - herb-roasted potato, Dorset Blue Vinney cheese, roasted Spanish onions, fresh spinach, tomato sauce and mozzarella.
- 4) Brentford Bantam - free-range chicken, roasted red peppers, field mushrooms, tomato sauce and mozzarella.

**OR** SALAD

- 1) Smoked Salmon - with shredded white cabbage, avocado, rocket, orange, roasted mixed seeds, pickled cucumber, white onion, fresh red and yellow peppers, flat-leaf parsley and a citrus vinaigrette.
- 2) Fennel and Feta - with rocket, roasted mixed seeds, raw grated beetroot and carrot, Lamb's Tongue leaves, basil and a tahini and lemon dressing.

**PLUS** PUDDING

- 1) Brownie (gluten-free) - warm chocolate brownie, with clotted cream
- 2) Crumble (gluten-free) - homemade apple and blackberry crumble pie, with clotted cream
- 3) Dairy-free option TBC
