Dear Liveryman,

Throughout its 653-year history, the Worshipful Company of Plumbers has valued the role of apprenticeships. The Apprentice's Statue in London's Cannon Street Station is a public demonstration of the part which apprentices play in the plumbing industry.

After an inaugural presentation of bursaries at the Statue last year, another event has been arranged on **Tuesday 13 March 2018** at which bursaries will be presented to a number of people who are currently undergoing training to become qualified to work in the industry. The bursaries (which have been provided by the Company's Education and Charitable Trust with generous support from City and Guilds of London Institute and Monument Tools) will enable the recipients to purchase plumbing tools.

This year's event will also celebrate World Plumbing Day (recognised every year, everywhere, on 11 March). This annual event was created by the World Plumbing Council in 2010 as a global opportunity to remind people of the essential role which plumbing plays in relation to the environment and public health.

After a short presentation ceremony beside the Apprentice Statue, lunch has been arranged in The Vintry, very close to Cannon Street Station.

Liverymen and their guests are welcome to join The Master, Wardens and members of the Court at the presentation event and to attend the lunch.

The timetable is as follows:

- 1250 Gather beside the Plumber's Apprentice Statue
- 1300 Presentation of bursaries
- 1330 Lunch at The Vintry

There is no cost for attending the presentation event and the cost of attending the lunch (a two-course meal with a half-bottle of wine or soft drink) will be £36, including gratuities.
