Master's Day at our New Plumbing Museum, Amberley Museum & Heritage Centre – Sunday 7th October 2018

The Master and his wife, Sheila, invite you and your family to join them at the Amberley Museum & Heritage Centre on Sunday 7th October on the special occasion of the formal opening by the Master of our New Plumbing Museum. The Master's Day Visit coincides with the Amberley Museum's Annual Historic Transport Gathering, providing the opportunity to see all types of vehicles, including commercial, transport and classic cars.

The Amberley Museum and Heritage Centre address is New Barn Road, Amberley, West Sussex, BN18 9LT and it is near Arundel on the B2139 between Storrington and Arundel, a short distance from the A29 and A27. Entry into the museum is through the museum car park, which adjoins Amberley Railway Station. The car park is free; as it is also the Historic Transport Gathering Day the car park may fill up quickly and early arrival is suggested to be certain of parking. For those who wish to travel by train Amberley Station is on the Southern Line from Victoria.

Amberley Museum covers some thirty-six acres and was once a busy chalk quarry. Its ethos is Trade, Technology and Transport and is a perfect location for our Museum of Traditional Plumbing Crafts. On the site there are forty-six diverse exhibition and workshop buildings of various sizes, including a significant exhibit by the Worshipful Company of Paviers. The

museum includes a narrow-gauge railway and traditional bus service, providing free transport to explore the site. Dress for the day should be appropriate for the occasion, but suitable for touring an open air museum. The museum is also dog friendly.

The charge for the visit includes entry into the museum and a list of those attending will be placed at the main entrance. The Plumbing Museum Trustees have arranged a light buffet lunch with wine, which will be in the 'Hayloft' situated at the rear of the museum office. The museum office is located immediately on the left as you enter the site.

- The Amberley Museum is open 10.00am to 5.00pm.
- 10.00am - Free to tour the Museum.
- 11.00am - Gather in the Hayloft for coffee
- 12.00noon - Gather at the Gin Building for formal opening of the Plumbing Museum.
- 1-2.00pm - Buffet Lunch in Hayloft.
- 2.00pm - Free to continue tour of Museum. - Departure at own discretion.

The charge for the day, which includes admission and the buffet lunch, is £25.00 per person. There is no charge for children under 10 years.
