### THE HOME OF THE CODE-BREAKERS A Visit to Bletchley Park, Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> June



What decided the outcome of World War 2? There are many possible answers. Three leading candidates must be Russian sacrifice, American wealth and British intelligence. Bletchley Park is preserved today as a monument to the men and women who broke the seemingly impenetrable Enigma code and went on to build “Colossus”, the world’s first programmable electronic computer, to assist in deciphering messages from the Lorenz machines used by the German High Command.

Today Bletchley Park offers a fascinating insight into the most secret War; a battle of raw intelligence which the enemy never discovered, let alone suspected that Britain and her allies might have won.

Our tour of the site and its many exhibits will be followed by a delicious three course lunch at “The Brasserie”. Situated just by Bletchley Park main gate, this highly regarded restaurant is staffed and run entirely by the students at Milton Keynes Catering College.

#### Itinerary

**10:30 – 10:45** Meet at Bletchley Park Visitors Centre. There is free car parking on site, or 9:49 am train from London Euston + 5 minute walk from Bletchley station.

**11:00 – 13:00** Group visit, including a 1 hour guided tour indoors and through the grounds of Bletchley Park (dress appropriately for the prevailing weather).

**13:15** Rendezvous at the Visitor Centre for a 5 minute walk to The Brasserie.

**13:30 – 15:00** Three course lunch, including glass of wine, beer or soft drink.

After lunch you are welcome to return to Bletchley Park or visit the National Museum of Computing within the grounds, to see the “Colossus” replica (a separate admission charge applies).

The cost of our Bletchley Park visit and lunch is just £34 per person.
