Election of the Lord Mayor – Monday 29th September 2014

This year's election of the Lord Mayor will be held at the Guildhall on Monday 29th September 2014 and Liverymen who were admitted to the Livery before the 31st May 2013 are eligible to vote. Alderman Alan Yarrow, the Alderman for Bridge Ward, in which the Company Church sits, is standing for election this year. Those who wish to attend Common Hall in the Guildhall to vote to approve the election of the Lord Mayor should note that, once again, passes will be required for entry. These may be obtained in advance only from this office. As in the past, Beadles from selected Companies will be on duty at the wicket gates to the Guildhall from 10.45 am onwards. Proceedings start at the Guildhall at 11.35am and Liverymen should be seated no later than 11.15am.
