

KILIMANJARO CHARITY TREK



IN AID OF THE PLUMBERS' COMPANY CHARITY

Past Steward Mike Horwood is once again off on his travels to raise money for the Plumbers' Charity. On 5th December he flies to Nairobi and after transferring to the foot of Mount Kilimanjaro, he starts his trek up the remote North East Rongai route to the summit at 5895 metres (19336 feet). It will take him 5 days, walking and climbing 10 to 15 hours a day over a total of 79 kilometres, the last stretch of which from the crater to the summit is a 210 meter ascent via glaciers and ice cliffs.

The Plumbers' Charity supports many good causes, from deprived and disadvantaged children in the East End of London to those in the Third World. We have recently helped fund the provision of proper sanitation for 2 primary schools in India and Africa, and plumbing training courses in Africa. We also provide awards for the top students in the Royal Navy, Army and Royal Air Force in plumbing and hydraulics and provide bursaries to young apprentices if they need financial assistance to help them qualify as plumbers. We are also helping fund a new plumbing craft course at More House School in Surrey for children with learning, language and communication difficulties.
