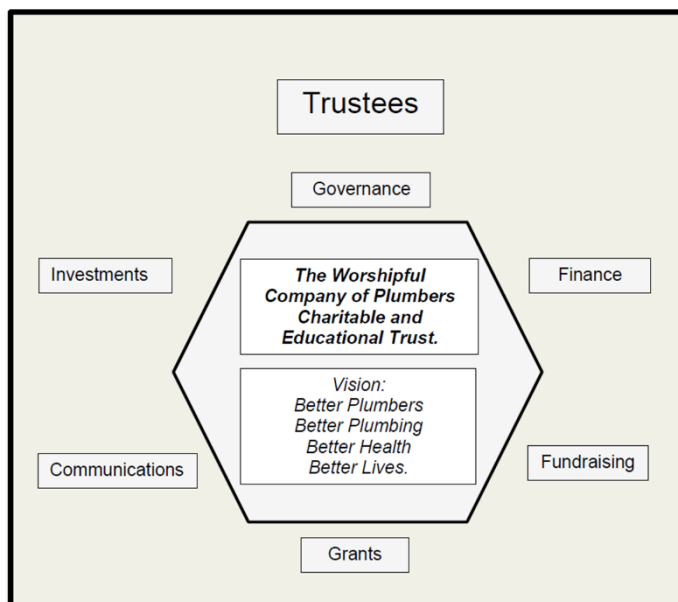
Some examples of how The Plumbers' Charity assists people and organisations include:

- The Lead craft demonstration facility at the Amberley Working Museum.

As mentioned above we have recently agreed an exciting new 5-year strategic plan to provide guidance to the Trustees for the future development of the Charity. Here is a diagram indicating the main activities undertaken by the Trustees.

Trustees serve for a period of five years, and may be reappointed for one further five-year term.

The Trustee board comprises of up to eight trustees, all of whom are liverymen of the Company. Four of those trustees can be members who are not on the Court.
