

## **COMPANY AWARDS**

### **St Michael Medallion - Criteria for the Award**

**(Revised by the Court July 2002)**

1. The Award shall be made to any person who, or organisation which, has made an outstanding contribution to the advancement of Plumbing.
2. The Freedom and Livery Committee shall bring a proposal for the Award to the attention of the Court.
3. This Award shall not be made on a regular basis but only on special occasions when warranted by the worthiness of the nominee.
4. Only members of the Court may make formal nominations to the Freedom and Livery Committee but other Liverymen may make informal recommendations to a member of the Court.
5. After the Freedom and Livery Committee have approved a nomination, the Committee will report to the next meeting of the Court with a recommendation and draft citation.
6. The Medallion shall be of silver gilt and of fine quality to the agreed design.
7. The Medallion shall be presented, if possible, at a major Company function.

The presentation of the Award, together with details of the associated Company function, shall be the subject of publicity in the National, City and Technical Press.
