

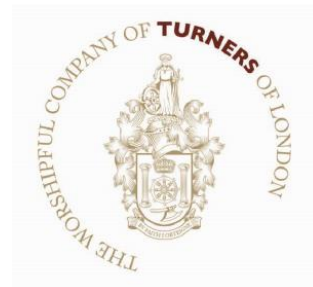

### Exhibition of outstanding contemporary woodturning

From the artistic to the incredible, the complex to the classic - view, love and buy outstanding contemporary woodturning in the historic setting of Apothecaries' Hall in the City of London.

**This unique one day exhibition combines entries to the 2014 competitions of the Turners' Company with curated collections of contemporary and historical woodturning.**

Around 200 items will be on display, making the exhibition one of the largest presentations of the 'art and craft' of woodturning ever held in London.

The **curated display of contemporary works** contains one exceptional piece from each of 25 leading UK and international woodturners. Many pieces feature techniques such as painting, piercing, carving and pyrography.

The Fiona Woolf Competition, named after the Lord Mayor, who is also an Honorary Liveryman of the Turners' Company, has the theme 'Energy in the Square Mile'. It has attracted some extraordinary and innovative entries.

The **historical display** has been curated by the collector Stuart King, reflecting his interest in traditional and rural crafts. The exhibits include both rare and domestic items, each the result of specialist knowledge and expertise, often gained after many years of training under a master.

**Apothecaries' Hall** is one of the oldest and most impressive Livery Halls in the City of London, dating back to 1672. The exhibition is in the Great Hall.

**Transport:** The entrance to Apothecaries' Hall is adjacent to Playhouse Yard and opposite Harry's Bar and the Camino bar in Black Friars Lane. Blackfriars Station (District & Circle lines, Thameslink and River Bus) and City Thameslink Station are each 5 minutes' walk. St Paul's tube station (Central line) is 10 minutes' walk. The nearest bus stop is Ludgate Hill/Old Bailey on routes 4, 11, 15, 17, 23, 26, 76, 100 & 172.
