Visit to HENLEY-ON-THAMES: Friday 14 July 2017

Henley-on-Thames is famous for its rowing, particularly the annual Henley Royal Regatta, its links to the River Thames, and its history (the town having received a Charter from Queen Elizabeth I in 1568). All three themes are presented at the **River and Rowing Museum**, which will be our first call.



Itinerary:

1045: Past Steward Michael Cooper (Mobile 07920 703656) will meet you in the reception of the River and Rowing Museum www.rrm.co.uk. Refreshments can be purchased at The Wild Fork Café on arrival if desired.

1100 - 1145: Guided tour of the museum. Then walk (15 mins) or drive across the bridge to our lunch venue.

1215: Lunch at The Little Angel Pub, Remenham Lane, Henley-on-Thames, RG9 2LS on the left-hand side, just past the Leander Club www.thelittleangel.co.uk. Summer menu options are expected shortly and will be circulated to those who book with a request for food choices.

1400: Return to the River and Rowing Museum. We have arranged two one-hour trips on the Consuta steam launch www.consuta.org.uk (12 passengers at a time, so 24 in total) from the public moorings near the museum to Temple Island and back. NB: As the Consuta is an open boat without any protection the trip is dependent on reasonable weather.

On completion: You are welcome to view the museum, browse the shop and depart at your leisure. Henley has many attractive shops and any boating enthusiasts may be interested to know that the Traditional Boat Festival runs from 14-16 July 2017 www.tradboatfestival.com/home.

Cost: Museum entry, free car parking, guided tour and river trip: £27 per person (£25 concessions - over 65s, under 18 or those in full-time education). Lunch – please pay on the day.

The Museum has its own car park (separate from the public parking in Mill Meadows). Please obtain an exit token from the museum reception desk when leaving.
