#### Item 1. Welcome:

The outgoing Chairman welcomed all to the meeting and reflected on 6 years as committee Chairman: he was pleased to have seen the success of the bursary scheme, the continued strength of annual lectures, the introduction of Certificates of Excellence and Installer Show visibility. Industry facilitation continues to be a challenge. He thanked all members of the committee and office team for their support.

emergency'. Additional actions for 2024 Lecture will be to increase marketing, in particular, through social media. This will be raised at the next communications meeting.

#### Item 4. Awards and Bursaries:

#### 4.1 Gold & Silver Medal:

- Gold Medal winner, Ruben Duggan won a bronze medal when he represented the UK in the European competition, he is a great ambassador for our livery.
- The Company silver medal is awarded to a candid ate who has achieved the NVQ level 2 certificate i n plumbing in difficult circumstances. Lvy.
